# 258-2025: Ethyl formate – new biosecurity treatment under AusTreat

5 August 2025

#### Who does this notice affect?

Pre-border biosecurity treatment providers and clients in the import and shipping industries – including freight forwarders, importers, and custom brokers associated with importing goods that are fumigated with ethyl formate.

### What has changed?

Ethyl formate (EF) in combination with carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) is a new biosecurity treatment for Brown Marmorated Stink Bug (BMSB) from 1 September 2025.

As part of implementation, the **Ethyl formate fumigation methodology (version 1.0)** and associated treatment documentation templates have been published and are available on the <u>Methodologies and documents for biosecurity treatments webpage</u> (https://www.agriculture.gov.au/biosecurity-trade/import/arrival/treatments/treatments-fumigants#ethyl-formate-fumigation).

The methodology outlines the minimum requirements for conducting ethyl formate fumigations on commodities and/or associated packaging for quarantine and pre-shipment purposes. It has been developed in consultation with stakeholders and subject matter experts, including through a Have Your Say survey that was open in June 2025.

Implementation of ethyl formate will be phased, beginning with offshore use as a pre-arrival treatment for the 2025-26 BMSB risk season, with plans for onshore use to follow in 2026-27. BMSB seasonal measures

(/biosecurity-trade/import/before/brown-marmorated-stink-bugs/offshore-bmsb-treatment-providers-scheme/treatment-guidance) will apply to targeted goods manufactured in or shipped from target risk countries, that have been shipped between 1 September and 30 April (inclusive), and to vessels that berth, load, or tranship from target risk countries within the same period.

Treatment providers wishing to conduct ethyl formate treatments must be registered under <u>AusTreat</u>

our offshore treatment assurance scheme. A registration form will be available on the <u>AusTreat webpage</u>

Treatment schedules have been developed and will be published prior to 1 September 2025.

We will host virtual information sessions for AusTreat treatment providers in August 2025. More information including dates and registration details will be released shortly.
